Classroom Expectations:

Grading:

5% participation (classroom workbook/preparation for class) 15% homework (labs, lesson reviews, study guides) 80% assessments (quizzes, exams)

Corrections/Retakes:

No points can be earned back on **participation**. This will be done during class as a whole group or partner. If absent, this must be made up.

Corrections can be made on some **homework** up to a 75%. The highest possible grade on **late work** is 75%. Study guides and lesson reviews are expected to be done when due so they can be used for the assessments.

Retakes can be taken <u>one time</u> on **quizzes** to improve your score up to 80%. All retakes must be completed by the module exam.

Retakes can be taken on **module exams** up to 80%. Students will be required to complete the Learn Smart program for the module to show an understanding of the material.

Academic Integrity:


Much of the daily workbook will be done collaboratively in my room. This will be graded as participation. I expect students to complete their homework independently. All quizzes and exams are done independently. Students who do not follow the guidelines for classwork will be handled on an individual basis. The consequences may include redoing the assignment, not allowing retakes, or earning a 0%. Cheating on assessments will be an automatic referral to the office. Parents will be informed on any action taken.

Absences:

If you are absent or plan to be absent, I encourage you or someone else to get your missed assignments if possible. If not, please email me or see me before school or during advisory time for your missed work. Quizzes and module exams can be taken early or will be made up when you return. This may be done during advisory, ELT, or before or after school.
