The Stratford FFA Scholarship is payable after the recipient has met all of the paperwork requirements as outlined by the high school office scholarship policy. Student must not be on academic probation. Please address thank you to the Stratford FFA Chapter.

Stratford FFA Alumni Scholarship:

The Stratford FFA Alumni Scholarship will be issued upon successful completion of 12 credits earned at a post high school institution (these may be accumulated in two college semesters). The recipient cannot be on grade probation to receive the scholarship money. Proof of tuition payment to continue in program should also be presented.
