## **CLASS REQUIREMENTS**

All students are required to carry 6.5 credits per year. Seniors may individually petition the principal, requesting to carry only 6 credits. Students are strongly encouraged to take seven credits each year. Twenty-six credits are required for graduation.

Students graduating have the following requirements: (a) Four credits of English; (b) Three credits of Social Science; (c) Three credits of Mathematics; (d) Three credits of Science; (e) One-half credit of Health; (f). One and one-half credits of Physical Education; (g) One- half credit of Personal Financial Literacy; (h) 10.5 elective credits; (i) have a minimum of five major components of the ACP checklist for each grade level of high school. (ACP documentation will be presented during advisory of the senior year and approved by a minimum of one of the following: advisor / counselor / principal) Complete a school counselor-approved exit interview and senior portfolio, which includes: resume, cover letter, letter of recommendation, two artifacts from each year of high school (8 total) and one artifact reflection from each year of high school (4 total); and (j) successfully pass the WI Civics Exam.
